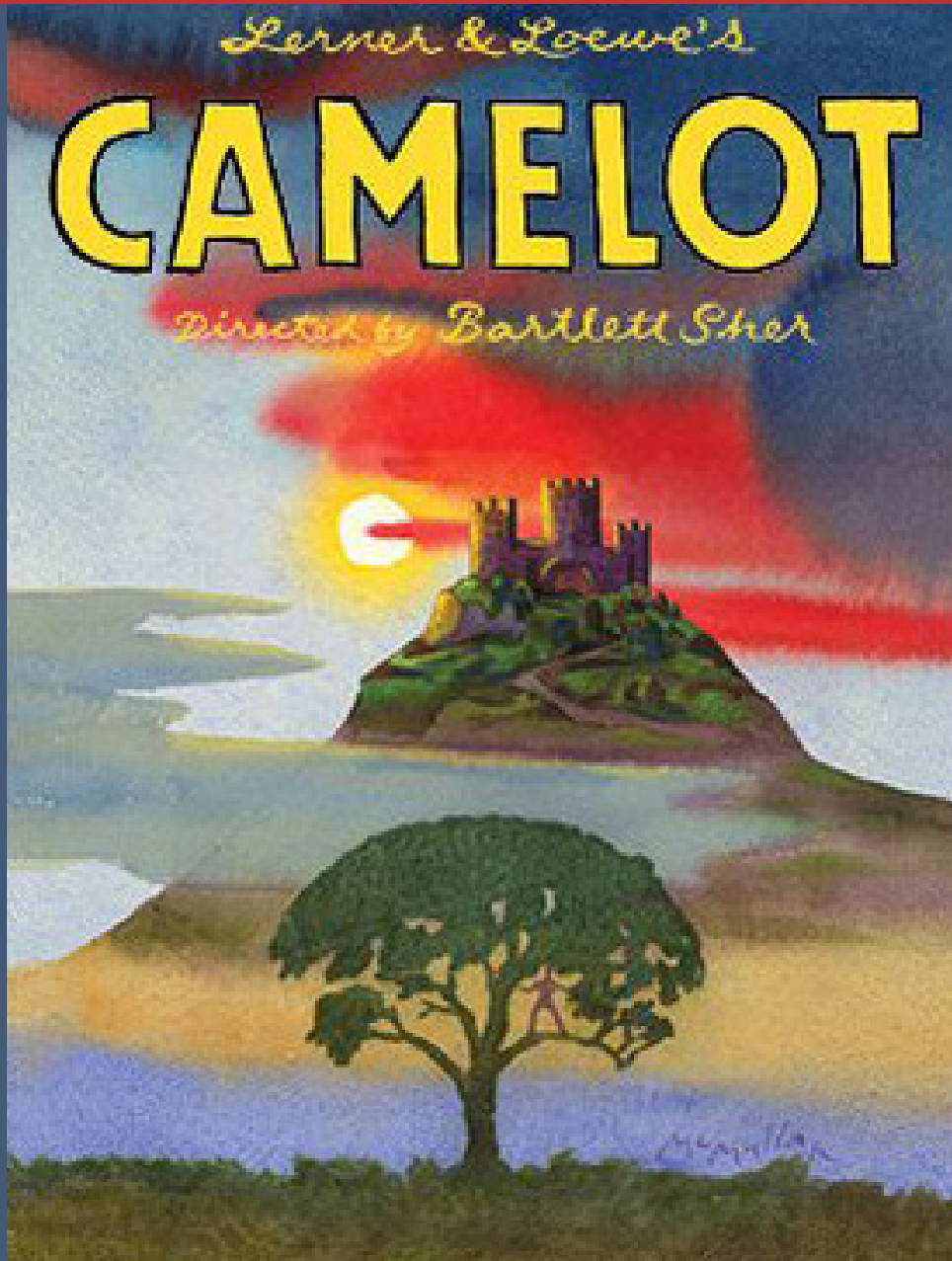

Reimagined for the 21st century, this fresh take on the classic tale based on the King Arthur legend features a book by Academy and Emmy Award winning writer Aaron Sorkin ("The West Wing," *To Kill A Mockingbird*), based on the original book by Alan Jay Lerner. The beloved original score with lyrics by Alan Jay Lerner and music by Frederick Loewe includes "If Ever I Would Leave You," "What Do the Simple Folk Do?" and the title song "Camelot."

An idealistic young King Arthur hopes to establish a kingdom built on honor and dignity personified by his Knights of The Round Table. His beliefs, however, are tested when his Queen Guenevere falls in love with the young Knight, Lancelot, and the fate of the kingdom hangs in the balance.

Tony Award® winner Bartlett Sher (*South Pacific*; *To Kill A Mockingbird*) directs a cast of 27, led by Tony winner Andrew Burnap (*The Inheritance*) as King Arthur, Phillipa Soo (*Hamilton*, *Encores! Into The Woods*) as Guenevere and Jordan Donica (Lincoln Center Theater's *My Fair Lady*) as Lancelot.
